CURRICULUM

Preschool Program for 3 and 4 year olds

- Children must be 3 by September 30th.
- The Preschool program "Allelu" helps young children take their first steps on the journey of faith.
- "Allelu" delivers a unique, multisensory experience.
- Christ-centered and age appropriate, "Allelu" offers lessons featuring Bible stories, music, crafts, prayer, games, and more. Kids engage all their senses as they gain the building blocks for a lifetime of Catholic Faith.
